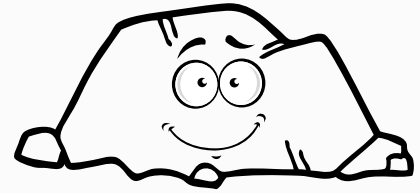

Get To Know a Rock!
